Our goal was to figure out how do students feel about their position in school.

We defined belonging to the school by being on a sports team or involved with a club in some way.

In order to determine how many students felt like they belonged to the school we had students take a survey on whether they feel a part of the school or not.

Results


- We polled 115 students in this survey.
- 63 students said that they feel apart of the school (51% of students.)

• 45 students said no (43% of students.)


Out of 115 student responses, 26% of students express they do not feel like they belong to our school.

However, other data contradicts these responses because of an estimate of at most 75% of students are either not in a club or a sport.

When asked why these students do not feel that they are apart of the school, a majority state that they are not involved with any clubs, activities or sports that take place during and or after school.

Do you feel part of the school and student body?






Why do you/don't you participate in

73.9% Student Felt Involved 26.1% Did Not Feel involved




